1. Introduction

vNotes is a voice memo creation application. Users can create voice memos in different file formats, save it to blackberry device memory or to the card memory. It supports full background recording and tagging of voice recordings with memos. VNotes also features a recording manager that allows user to tag a recording, preview a recording, rename and delete a recording.

1.1 Features

- Highly optimized Blackberry® Pearl™ 8100 smartphones
- Voice notes creation in various formats
- Supported codec formats are AMR-NB, AU, Wave (standard, uLaw, aLaw)
- Saving voice recording files to device memory and card memory
- Full background recording allowing user to use other applications while recording
- Tagging voice recordings with memos
- Recordings management with instant preview/play, rename and remove recordings
- User friendly interface
- One-time payment – lifelong Free upgrades and bug fixes
- Premier customer support via e-mail and community forums

2. System Requirement

- RIM Blackberry® OS 4.2 or higher
- 92K of free memory
- External MicroSD card is required for saving to and reading files from card

3. Installation

3.1 Using Blackberry Desktop Manager

You can download the zip archive extract to your personal computer use the 'Blackberry Desktop Manager' – Application loader, select and install the vNotes.alx file it will install the corresponding cod file to your Blackberry® Pearl™ 8100.

3.2 Using OTA

Alternatively you can use the Over the Air (OTA) install option by pointing to the jad file from your Blackberry browser and continue with the installation. OTA install file is located at <http://www.dollars5.com/OTA/vNotes.jad>

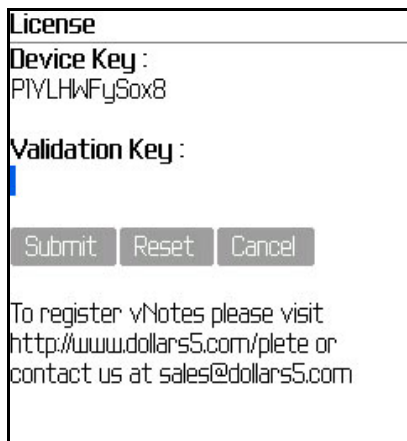
Once installed vNotes will require license information to continue. The license can be purchased from Dollars 5 Complete website or its partner websites listed in the partners' page.

4. Launching vNotes

To launch vNotes look for the icon in the Home screen/ Applications list and select it to start vNotes application.



On successful first launch user will require to enter his license validation key. Once validated, user will be taken to the application screen.



4.1 Registering vNotes

vNotes requires license configuration and validation to continue for the first time. Purchase a vNotes professional edition license from Dollars 5 Complete website at <http://www.dollars5.com/plete> or by contacting sales@dollars5.com

Registering vNotes as professional edition is a three step procedure:

1] Purchase of professional license:

To purchase a professional edition license user is required to make the purchase from the website with contact details and correct e-mail address at the time of making payment.


2] Mail the Device Key:

After purchase present Dollars 5 Complete with the device key information that can be located under License as illustrated. User can select and copy the key and mail from his blackberry device e-mail itself to sales@dollars5.com together with transaction information and provided e-mail address.

3] Validating using the Validation Key:

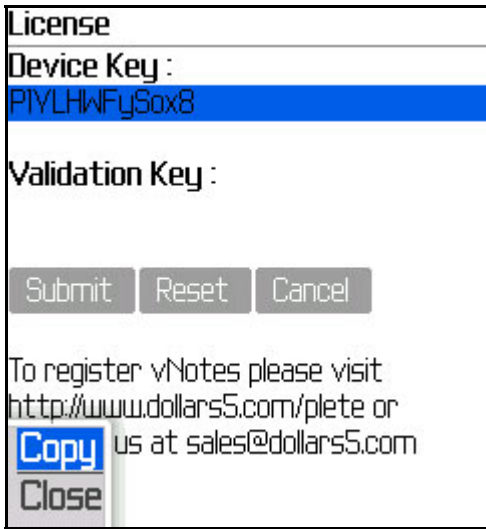
On receipt of the device key and transaction details Dollars 5 Complete will mail the Validation key to the provided e-mail address, which should be entered in the License screen.

Once validated only the validation key will be shown on the license screen.

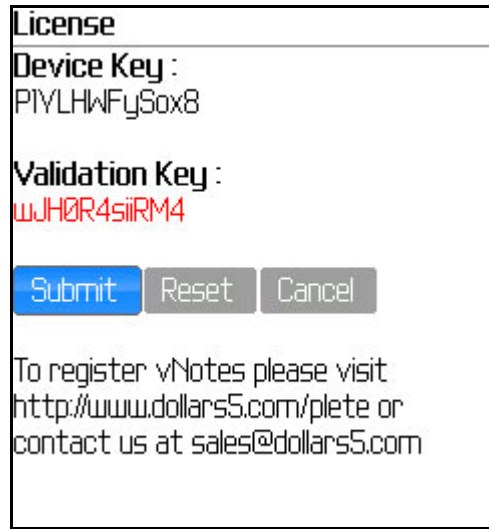

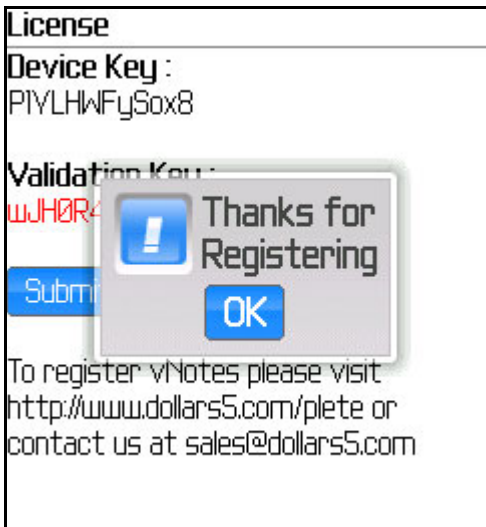

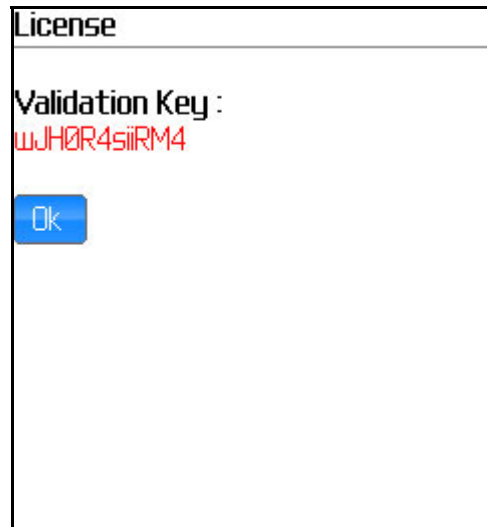
Copying Device Key

5. User Interface

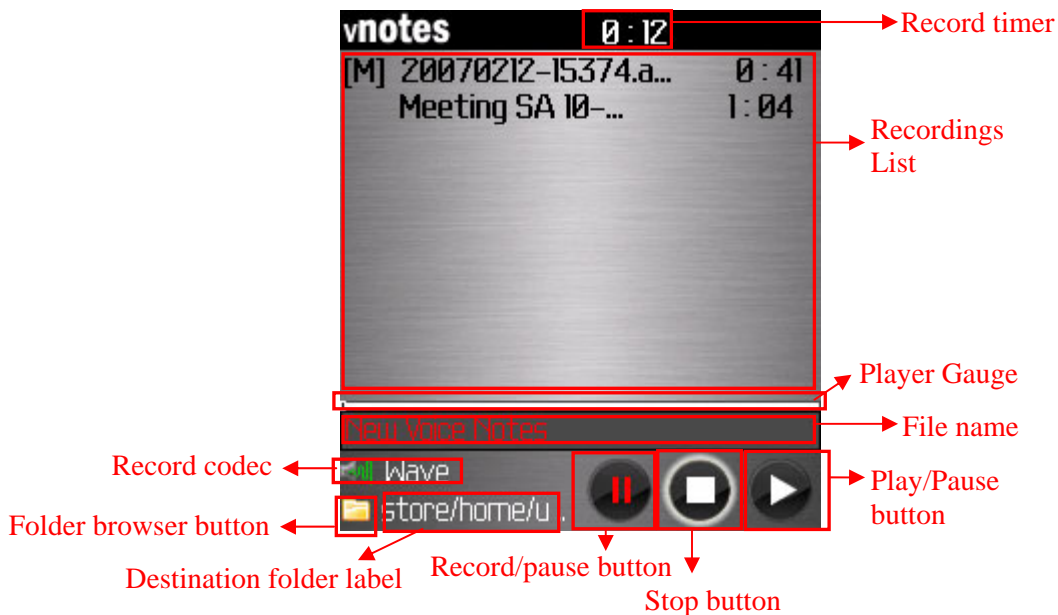
vNotes can create voice memos in different file formats, save it to device memory or to card memory.

The supported record formats/codecs are:

AMR-NB - 12.2 kbps (.amr)

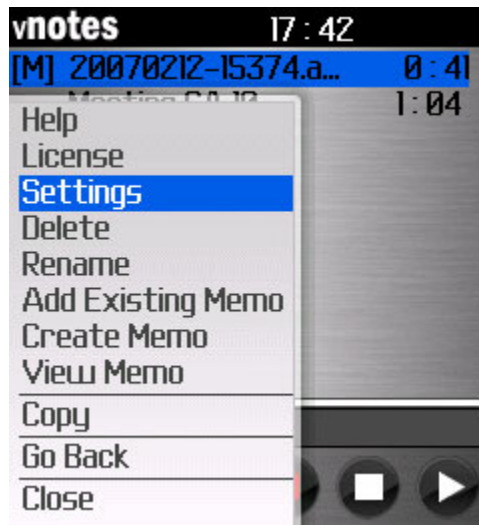
Next AU sound (.au)

WAV PCM/uLaw/aLaw - 8 kHz 16-bit depths in mono (.wav)



Buttons/items	Descriptions
Record timer	While a recording is in progress indicates the duration of the recording
Recordings List	List of all recordings with tag and duration, can be selected and played
Player gauge	Indicates the play duration visually
Filename	Edit this field to set a name to the recorded file
Record Codec	Set record format/codec
Folder browser button	Launches file explorer to select the destination folder to save the recording
Record/Pause button	Start a recording session, with set settings, while recording in progress use it to pause or continue
Stop button	Stop a recording session or a play preview
Play/Pause button	Play a selected recording from the list for preview

5.1 Menu Options



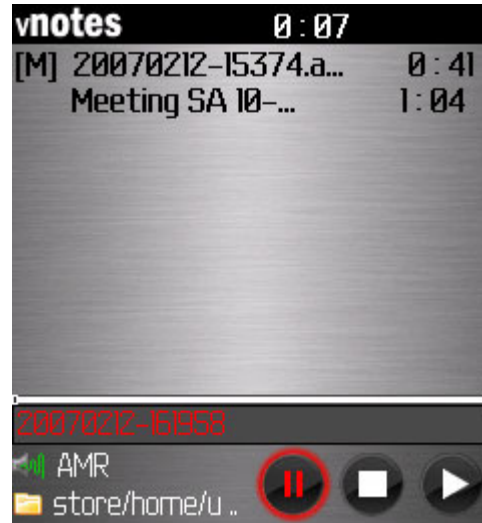
Menu options	Descriptions
Help	In-application help functionality
License	License information display
Settings	Configuration settings for vNotes
Delete	Delete selected recording from list and/or memory
Rename	Rename a recording filename
Add Existing Memo	Add/replace a memo tag to the selected recording
Create Memo	Create/replace a new memo tag for the selected recording
View Memo	View a tagged memo for the selected recording
GoBack/Close	Exit vNotes, if any text document is edited prompts to save.

5.2 Create a simple voice memo

To create a voice memo, select a codec/record format from the list, set folder location (skip it to use the default location), set file name (skip to use default file naming based on date-time or to prompt after recording), click record button to begin recording, it is indicated by the record button turning red and timer progressing.

Recording can be paused by hitting the record pause button, to resume hit the resume recording button again. Once stopped by clicking the stop button, user will see a status alert indicating file is being saved.



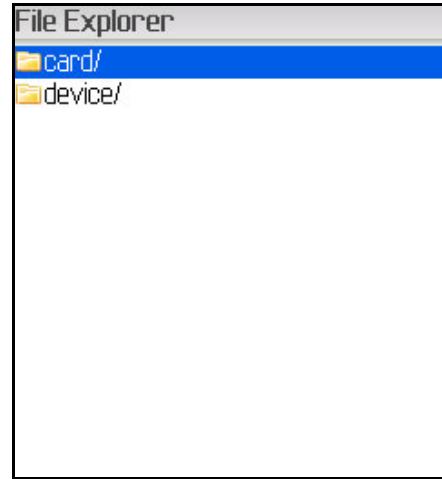
Pause and resume recording



Record location alert

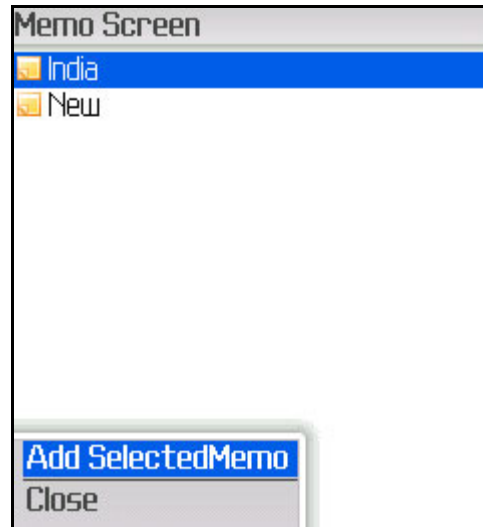
5.3 Setting a file destination folder

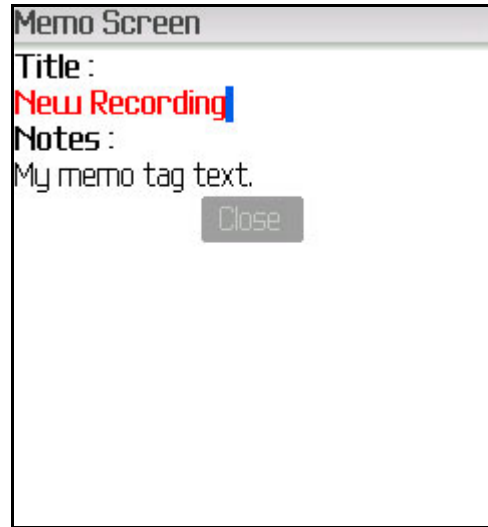
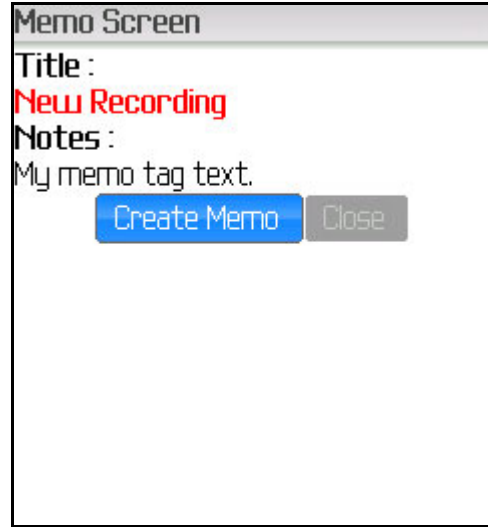
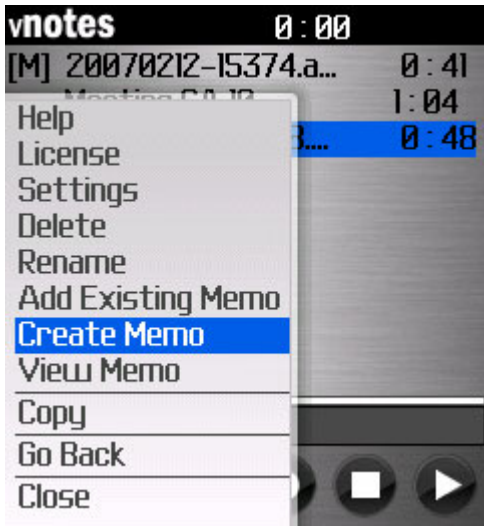
Should the file be saved to other location than the default destination location, navigate to the folder browser button to launch file explorer to select a new destination folder.



5.4 Add a Memo tag to the recording

A voice note can be tagged with a memo for recalling or for additional notes purposes. An existing memo from Memopad application can be added or a new memo can be created and added. Tagging an already tagged recording will replace the recording. View memo will display the tagged memo, if no memo present will allow user to create one. The presence of memo tag is indicated by a [M] symbol before the recording name.



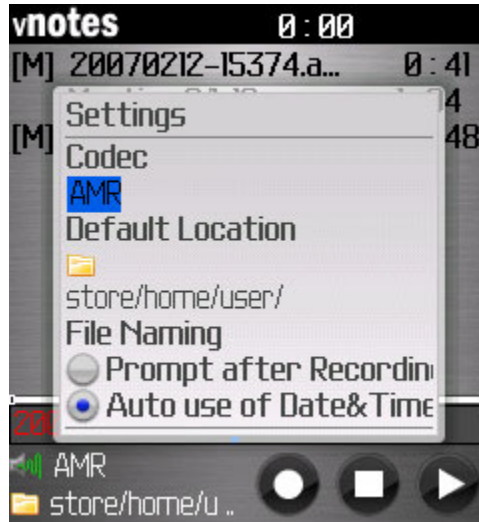


5.5 Rename/Remove recording

A selected recording can be renamed using the Rename menu option. A selected recording can be removed from list and/or from memory by using the Remove menu option. After delete a prompt to confirm file deletion will allow user to delete/retain file from memory.

6. Settings

Various vNotes settings can be accessed from the Menu Settings option.

Codec	Default recording format/codec
Default folder	Setting for default folder for vNotes recordings
File naming	Setting for automatic file naming based on date-time or to prompt after recoding
